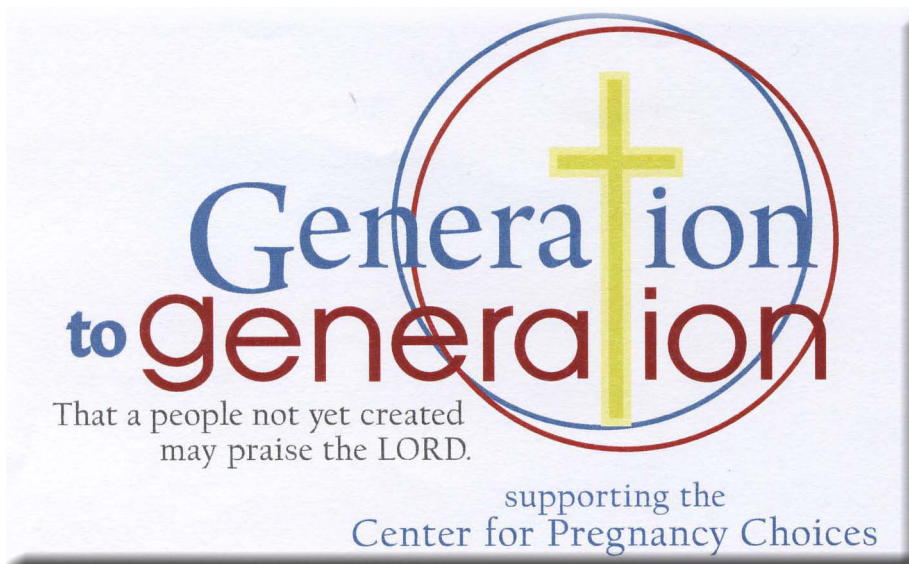
Just a Bit from Patty Fultz

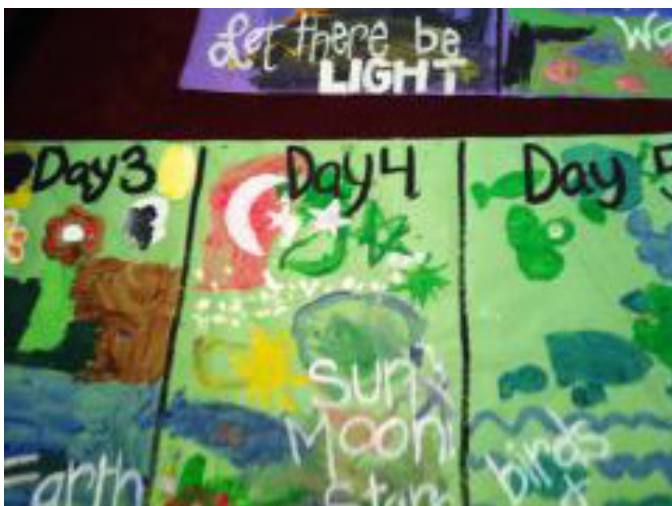
